**Mesa's Bautista, Cuyamaca's Toledo share PCAC honor**

San Diego Mesa College basketball player Carolina Bautista and Cuyamaca track & field athlete Carolina Toledo have been honored by the Pacific Coast Athletic Conference as Women's Athletes of the Week for all sports.

Bautista, a 5-foot-8 freshman guard from Sweetwater High School, contributed 29 points and 19 rebounds as the Olympians took home back-to-back victories during the week, running their win streak to 14 games, and clinched the outright conference championship.

Bautista had a career-high 19 points and added seven rebounds in Wednesday's 60-57 win over second-place Southwestern which clinched no worse than a tie for the title. On Friday, she had 10 points and 13 rebounds as Mesa turned back MiraCosta 64-53 to wrap up the undisputed championship with two games to play.

Toledo, a sophomore from Otay Ranch High School, got off a 38.15-meter (125 feet, 2 inches) effort to win the hammer throw in the Coyotes' season-opening 68-64 victory over Antelope Valley. She also captured a first place in the javelin throw.

Honorable mention selections were Palomar tennis player Mardee Littrell and San Diego City College softball players McKenna Clark and Nicole Clites.

Littrell, a sophomore from Valley Center High, won twice in No. 1 singles as the Comets opened their season with back-to-back road victories over Saddleback (9-0) and Riverside Community College (5-4). Littrell came from behind to defeat the Gauchos' No. 1 player Jeanette Lusaria 3-6, 6-2, 10-3. She swept RCC's Brooke Vorhees 7-6 (1), 6-4.

Clark, a freshman shortstop from Monte Vista High School, went 2-for-3 with two runs scored in a 7-1 in over Glendale and was 2-for-2 with a solo home run, three runs scored, a walk and a stolen base in the Knights' 8-0 rout of Los Angeles Pierce. She also handled nine chances at short and helped turn two double plays in the Glendale game.

Clites, a freshman pitcher / third baseman from Madison High, went 3-for-3 with two homers and five RBIs vs. Pierce and also was the winning pitcher against the Brhamas, allowing two hits in 4 1/3 innings.
