Collective Bargaining (Labor Studies 104, CRN 05263) will provide a comprehensive overview of major bargaining issues, bargaining climate, impasse and arbitration procedures, and negotiation strategies. The course will include mock negotiations and workplace role playing, as well as discuss hypothetical collective bargaining situations. Course content is intended to help the employee activists develop leadership skills necessary for effective employee representation and collective bargaining agreement development.
