Occupational Safety and Health (Labor Studies 123A, CRN 05291) provides a comprehensive overview of work-related injuries, illness and death in the United States. Students will learn through discussion and hands-on training how to identify and analyze a full range of hazards – chemicals, ergonomics, unsafe equipment; how Cal/OSHA and Workers' Compensation work; elements of a comprehensive illness and injury prevention program; how to form effective health and safety committees; effective communication skills; contract language and grievances, and resources and strategies for taking successful action.
