Fitness Tip: Steps in Choosing the Correct Walking or Running Shoe for You!

The next step in picking the right shoe is to gather information on the shoes that are available. You can read the advertisements or talk to shoe sales people but at times this can leave you skeptical since they might be motivated by sales rather than what is best for you. Its important to realize that a popular brand or a high price is no guarantee of a proper shoe for you.

Provided below are a few suggestions:

- I. Look at the various kinds of available shoes.
 - a. Find out what features are useful to your walking or running style.
 - b. Talk to other people about what works.
 - c. Observe what happens to various types of shoes.
- II. Try on several shoes.
 - a. Comfort is the most important feature.
 - b. Try them the way you plan to use them and with or without socks, orthotics and insoles.
 - c. Make sure they fit well by leaving 1/2 inch of space from end of shoe to end of toe when you stand in them.
 - d. Ensure you have a close fit from ball of foot to the heel but room for the toes to move.
 - e. Don't expect them to break in.
 - f. Finally, walk or run in them to make sure they perform as you expect them too.
