Important Information That Could Affect Your Pay!

For full-time and adjunct classroom faculty: Thursday, December 11, 2008 at 11:59AM is the last day to enter and/or mark your Fall '08 Flex activities complete. If you are reading this message, you are at a computer with Internet access so why not click here now and check the status of your Flex contract? Per the Flex Guidelines, Item 6, "Faculty who do not meet their Instructional Improvement (Flex) obligation will have their pay docked for each hour that is not completed." No one wants this. However, it's an indication of how important it is to accurately report instructional hours to the state. All are encouraged to follow-up on Flex as soon as possible.

Heidi Fox, Admin. Technician for the VP Instruction Office, will be available in the faculty work room, R-101, during the following dates and times to assist in reviewing and updating your Flex contract. R-101 is accessible through the main entrance of the LRC and is located on the bottom floor. One half-hour Flex credit will be given to those that attend.
