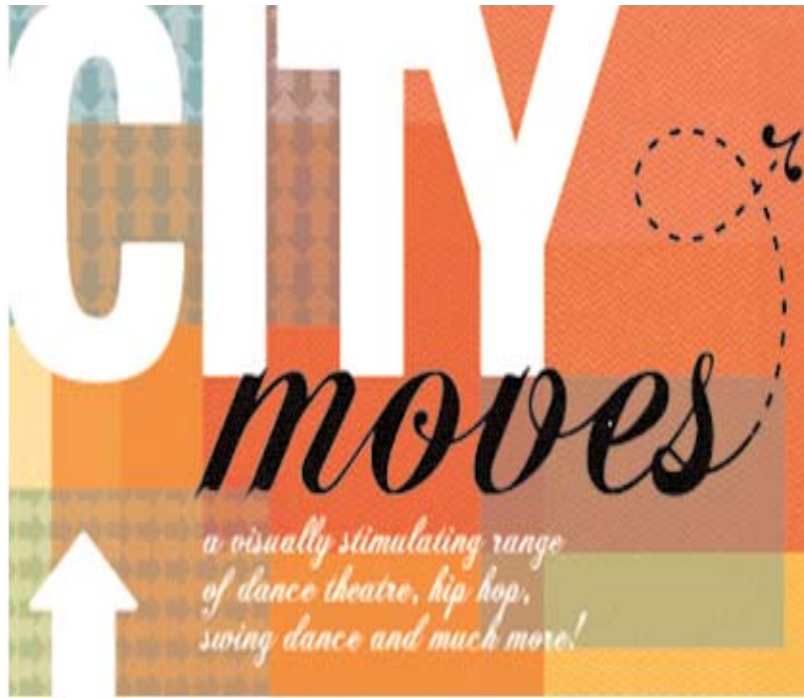
## Athletic Information

### Fitness Tip: [Information on an Enlarged Heart](#)

An enlarged heart is a sign the heart is overworked. Heart enlargements can be pathological which is related to significant heart disease or physiological which is related to exercise.

An enlarged heart is an indication of an underlying condition. If its associated with heart disease, doctors will often attempt to treat the underlying disease at the same time as the enlarged heart. An enlarged heart is often present during heart failure when the heart cannot pump adequate blood to meet the metabolic needs of the body. An enlarged heart may have symptoms such as shortness of breath, dizziness or irregular heart beat.

Treatment for an enlarged heart can include medications like beta blockers and controlling other conditions such as high blood pressure. With proper treatment the condition may be controlled or even reversed. (Greer)
