IGETC General Education will total 34 or more units. The remaining units needed to total 60 transferable units will consist of Major Preparation and/or Elective transferable units.

Students have the option of enrolling in the summer to make up units in the event a course from the previous year has to be repeated, or to get a head start for the following year. Please note that this is a *typical* education plan that will not work for all students. Certain majors (especially impacted ones) and certain schools (e.g. Schools of Engineering) recommend other general education patterns. Students should work with the Honors Counselor to determine their best course of study.

IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum) is a list of courses that have been approved to fulfill the lower division general education requirements at all the California State Universities and at most of the University of California campuses. Upon transfer, no additional lower division general education requirements are required for IGETC certified students.
