

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
Between

COGSWELL POLYTECHNICAL COLLEGE
and
SAN DIEGO CITY COLLEGE

The purpose of the articulation agreement is to guide students who intend to pursue a Bachelor's degree in one of Cogswell College (CPC) majors, after fulfilling some of the lower division requirements at San Diego City College.

The attached document lists the courses required at CPC for each degree and the comparable courses at San Diego City College. Both General Education and discipline specific courses may be transferred. A maximum of 70 semester credits can be transferred to CPC from a two-year institution. In some cases two courses at San Diego City College are equivalent to one three-credit course at CPC. The recommended transfer courses were chosen to maximize the student's preparation within the constraint of the 70-credit limit.

After completing the recommended courses at San Diego City College, students can be admitted to CPC as juniors. It is possible for them to complete the requirements for the Bachelor's degree in two years. However, because of course prerequisites and lower division CPC requirements not available at San Diego City College, it is essential that students plan the transition with the help of CPC advisors while attending San Diego City College.

The agreement between the two institutions, signed by the articulation officers, becomes effective on the date of the signatures. The agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and revised as necessary if changes in the programs occur.
