Admissions Requirements

- 2.0 GPA or higher required
- All general education courses with "C" or higher accepted
- 2-year college courses may apply for upper division credit
- Can transfer up to 90 semester (or 135 quarter) hours from regionally accredited two-year institutions

Graduation Requirements

- Must complete 186 quarter hours with a 2.0 GPA or higher
- Must successfully complete at least 48 quarter hours from Capella University
