

**GE Requirements for Chapman University (Orange, CA)  
2007-2008**

**Shared Inquiry Courses (18-19 semester credits)**

<b>Artistic Inquiry</b> (3 semester credits) Transferable courses typically found under fine arts and sometimes humanities. Includes: Art, Drama/Theatre, Dance (theory), English (Creative Writing and Literature), Film (theory), Music
<b>Quantitative Inquiry</b> (3 semester credits) Courses determined to be equivalent to MGSC 208 (Business Calc), MATH 110 (Calc 1 or higher level calculus), MATH 203 (Statistics), PSY 203 (Behav. Science Statistics)
<b>Natural Science Inquiry</b> (3-4 semester credits) Any transferable lecture <u>with lab</u> natural science course or direct equivalency to a Chapman approved course.
<b>Social Inquiry</b> (3 semester credits) Transferable courses typically found under the social sciences: History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology. Also includes subjects not offered at CU but commonly transferred: Ethnic Studies, Cultural/Civilization studies, Cultural or World Geography.
<b>Values and Ethical Inquiry</b> (3 semester credits) Transferable courses under Philosophy or Religion.
<b>Written Inquiry</b> (3 semester credits) College level writing course equivalent or comparable in outcomes to ENG 103 Freshman Rhetoric or ENG 104 Writing About Literature.

**Exploration Clusters (27 semester credits)**

<b>Freshman Foundation Program</b> Waived for transfer students with 15 transferable units
<b>Inter/Multidisciplinary Cluster</b> (12 semester credits, minimum 6 upper division) Transfer credit directly equivalent to a Chapman course can be accepted in this requirement. Students may select from list of approved clusters. <a href="http://www.chapman.edu/academics/GE/catalog2007/multiDisciplinary.asp">http://www.chapman.edu/academics/GE/catalog2007/multiDisciplinary.asp</a> Completion of a minor or second major satisfies this requirement.
<b>Global Citizen Cluster</b> (12 semester credits) <b>-Global Study</b> (6 credits) Courses that explore world cultures (contemporary) and/or human diversity, study abroad or travel course are approved for this area. <b>-Citizenship, Community, and Service</b> (3 credits) May be satisfied by equivalent coursework in transfer to any course on Chapman's approved list or those approved by articulation agreement. <b>-Language Study</b> (3 credits) A language course at or above the 200-level, a course taught in the language, or documented functional language use. This means any course listed equivalent to our 201 or higher language courses. Notes: Conversation courses that require one year language prerequisite will not be accepted. Sign language not accepted.

**IGETC or CSU certification satisfies the following:**

- All Shared Inquiry areas (18/19 cr.)
- Global Study and Citizenship, Community, and Service (9 cr.)

**Remaining GE requirements include:**

- Inter/Multidisciplinary Cluster (12 credits)
- Language (3 credits)

Students who transfer with full/complete certification may use applicable coursework towards the remaining GE requirements.
