### ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) A minimum of 90 semester units or 135 quarter hours are required. (Beginning with the Fall 2003 class, 30 of the semester unites must be of upper division.)
- 2) All units must be transferable towards a bachelor's degree, and science pre-requisites must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.
- 3) A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 for all undergraduate course work is required.

Minimum Pre-Professional Science Credits (similar to pre-medicine, pre-dental, etc.)

<b>BIOLOGY:</b> One academic year (2 semesters or 3 quarters) <b>with related labs</b> , which can include: Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, General Biology, Zoology. 
