GENERAL EDUCATION GUIDELINES
SAN DIEGO CITY COLLEGE

- *This is **not** an articulation agreement, but a recommended guideline of courses Concordia University will accept from San Diego City College to fulfill Concordia's General Education requirements. (Exceptions may be made on a case by case basis.)*
- *Concordia accepts CSU and IGETC transfer Certification to waive General Education except for areas C3, E1 and E3. Students who are in progress to complete one of the above Certification patterns are encouraged to do so.*
- *A student may transfer to Concordia with a minimum of 24 semester (36 quarter) units of transferable college credit. A student with fewer units will be evaluated on the basis of both high school and college records.*
- *If Elementary Education is your career goal, please contact the Concordia University School of Education at (949)854-8002, ext. 1355 for courses transferable to meet subject matter equivalents.*

AREA B: SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS

All Concordia students must complete two science courses with labs: one Physical and one Biological. Only students who have completed CSU or IGETC Certification are exempt from this requirement.
