## **Transfer Admission Eligibility\***

All transfer applicants must meet the following requirements to be considered for admission:

- Complete a minimum of 60 CSU-transferable semester units.
- Complete General Education (GE) requirements in written communication, oral communication, critical thinking, and mathematics with a “C” or higher in each course.
- Earn a minimum 2.0 cumulative CSU-transferable GPA. Applicants must meet this GPA at the time of application and must maintain the GPA prior to transfer.
- Be in good standing at the last college or university attended.

Applicants who meet the requirements listed above will be ranked based on the completion of lower division General Education and preparation for the major coursework. Out-of-service area applicants will be selected based on a GPA ranking that may be higher than the major GPA. Visit

## **Notes**

- Additional Major Admission Requirements: All transfer students who wish to enroll as music majors or minors are given placement examinations in music theory and piano and auditions on their major instrument. On the basis of these examinations and auditions, recommendations of specific courses will be made by the music faculty advisor. Students are subject to placement examinations, auditions, and placement in specific courses regardless of coursework completed at other institutions.
- Other Requirements: See the SDSU catalog under “Music” for important information about other requirements for music majors.
- Foreign Language: Third semester competency or equivalent in one foreign language is required as part of preparation for the major. This requirement may be completed at community college or SDSU.
