Webster University is an independent, multi-campus, nondenominational institution offering undergraduate and graduate degrees. The home campus is located in St. Louis, Missouri. Founded in 1915 and accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools since 1925, Webster University has grown into an international network of campuses across the United States and Europe. The university now enrolls over 15,000 students worldwide at over 100 campuses.

The San Diego Campus offers undergraduate degree completion programs (leading to a B.A.) in Business Administration and Management with the option to minor in Computer Applications or Web Site Development. A variety of graduate programs (M.A. and M.B.A.) are also available in the areas of Business and Management.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must submit the following to be considered for admission into the program.

- ◆ A completed application for transfer admission
- ◆ A \$25 nonrefundable application fee
- ◆ A 300-500 word minimum autobiographical essay
- ◆ Official transcripts from *each* college or university attended

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ An A.A. or A.A.S. degree from an accredited college OR the equivalent of two years of college level work (a minimum of 56 transferable semester units)
- ◆ 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale

GENERAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Students will be awarded a Baccalaureate Degree based on the following requirements.

- ◆ Successful completion of 128 semester credit hours
- ◆ Successful completion of at least 30 of the student's final 36 semester credit hours through Webster University to satisfy residency hours requirements
- ◆ Successful completion of the specific requirements for the major (36 or 39 semester credit hours - 18 of which must be earned directly through Webster University)
- ◆ Successful completion of 27 semester credit hours of general education
- ◆ A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 in all courses taken at Webster University

TRANSFER POLICIES*

Webster University accepts up to a maximum of 98 semester hours of transfer work from other accredited institutions. No more than 64 credit hours may be transferred from a community college, standardized tests, or other lower-division institutions unless the credits are part of a successfully completed Associates Degree. All transfer courses must be college level and have been completed with a "C" or better. Courses in which the student earned a "D" are subject to review and might not be accepted for transfer.

Webster University accepts credits earned through standardized exams such as CLEP and DANTES. Webster University follows the credit recommendations of the American Council on Education (ACE) for various corporate and military training programs.

General Education Equivalencies

Webster University requires the completion of 3 semester hours in each of these general education areas:

- ◆ Critical Thinking
 - ◆ Communications
 - ◆ Historical Consciousness
 - ◆ Humanities
 - ◆ Values
 - ◆ Cultural Understanding
 - ◆ Arts Appreciation
 - ◆ Scientific Understanding
 - ◆ Mathematics
- ◆ IGETC: Students who have completed the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) have completed the equivalent of Webster University's general education program and are not required to complete additional lower-division general education coursework.
 - ◆ CSU General Education Breadth Requirements: Students who have completed the CSU General Education Breadth Requirements have completed the equivalent of Webster University's general education program and are not required to complete additional lower-division general education coursework.
 - ◆ Associates Degree: Students who have completed the Associate of Arts Degree (A.A.) or the Associate of Science Degree (A.S.) at the community college level have completed the equivalent of Webster University's general education program and are not required to complete additional lower-division general education coursework.

Evaluation of **all transfer credit can be conducted preliminarily by an academic advisor at the San Diego Campus but is ultimately approved and officially added to the student's transcript by the office of the registrar as a part of the admissions process.*

CALENDAR

The San Diego Campus offers five 8-week semesters per year. Classes meet weekly in the evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Saturday courses are offered on occasion. Annual course schedule available in the transfer center.

TUITION

For the academic year 2002 - 2003 (Fall 1, 2001 - Summer, 2002), undergraduate tuition is \$280 per credit hour. Part time tuition (one class per semester) is \$840; full time tuition (two classes per semester) is \$1680.
