

CSU Northridge Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

Benefits

- Guaranteed admission to CSU Northridge during semester of student's choice
- CSU Northridge academic advising services and invitations to campus events

Eligibility (to apply for the program)

- Completed at least 15 CSU-transferable semester units
- California resident
- Not previously disqualified from attending a CSU campus
- Not available to students entering an impacted major at CSU Northridge (as of Spring 2006, these are Accountancy, Financial Services and Financial Planning).
- Must submit TAG agreement no later than one year prior to intended transfer term.

Requirements (to transfer)

- Complete 60 CSU-transferable semester units
- Maintain a minimum 2.00 (2.40 for nonresidents) overall GPA
- Complete 30 units of general education, including all four CSU general education basic subject courses (Written Communication, Oral Communication, Mathematical Concepts, and Critical Thinking) with a "C" or better, **OR** complete IGETC general education pattern **OR** complete CSU General Education Breadth Certification Plan.
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended
- Submit CSU Application for Admission while the campus is still accepting applications for the preferred term and comply with all CSU requirements and deadlines
- Apply for admission to a major which is not impacted and is still accepting new students for the term of transfer

Conditions & Notes

- Does not guarantee admission to the major
- Critical Thinking is waived for declared Engineering and Computer Science majors
- Students are strongly recommended to complete lower division preparation for the major at community college

How To Participate

- Schedule a one-hour appointment with a counselor to complete a CSU Northridge TAG education plan and sign the TAG contract
