Eligibility (what you need to apply for the program)

- Current senior or recent graduate of a San Diego County high school starting first semester at community college (with no gap in schooling other than summer break).
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Requirements (what you need prior to transfer)

- Complete 60 UC-transferable semester units
- Maintain a minimum 2.80 cumulative GPA in all UC-transferable courses
- Meet UC subject eligibility by completing required transfer coursework
- Complete 30 UC-transferable units, at least two regular semesters, and the last term of enrollment prior to admission at a California Community College
- Complete 1 individual appointment with UniversityLink counselor each semester
- Complete 1 individual visit with UCSD advisor each year
- Complete Personal Growth 127 during first year at City College
- Satisfactory participation in UniversityLink meetings, workshops, and activities
- Attend a UCSD application workshop
- Attend a UCSD campus visit
- Submit UC Admission Application during filing period and comply with all UC requirements and deadlines

Conditions & Notes

- Admission to UCSD during the fall semester only
- Admission to UCSD undergraduate college and major are not guaranteed
- Can be supplemented/combined with UCSD TAG program
