- Some UCSD colleges require additional lower division G.E. courses. Some of these courses may be completed prior to transfer:

MUIR: By graduation, you must complete 1 course that emphasizes U.S. Cultural Diversity. It can be lower division.

MARSHALL: In making your core selection E: If you select a year sequence of natural sciences, you must complete 1 additional course in calculus or statistics. If you select a year sequence in calculus, you must complete 2 additional semester courses (3 quarter courses) in natural science, one in each discipline. Additional courses: 1 course in ethnic studies or third world studies.

REVELLE: In making your core selection E: Select 2 courses in calculus. In addition, 1 biology and a total of 3 semesters of physics and chemistry (at least 1 from each subject). Additional course: 1 course in music, art, or theatre; can be taken at the community college. Additional course: Complete 3rd semester level of foreign language (or pass the UCSD language exam after transfer).

ROOSEVELT: In making your core selection B: Select 2 courses from art, drama/theatre, or music. If available you should take 1 course in a non-western emphasis. In making your core selection E: Select 2 courses in natural science from biology, chemistry or physics. In addition, you should take 2 semester courses, chosen from the following areas: math, computer programming, logic, and/ or statistics. These can be taken at the community college. Additional course: Complete 3rd semester level of foreign language (or pass the UCSD language exam or take a 4th quarter of language after transfer).

Neither **WARREN** nor the **SIXTH COLLEGE** requires additional lower division GE.
