ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- IGETC is a general education pattern that community college transfer students may use to fulfill lower-division general education requirements in either the California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) systems. **IGETC is recommended for students who have not made a final decision about transferring to a particular CSU or UC campus.** Students that have made a decision may be better served by following the CSU General Education Certification requirements or the general education requirements of the campus to which they plan to transfer.
- Each course must have been IGETC approved at the time it was taken.
- AP credit is allowed to fulfill IGETC requirements. CLEP credit is not.
- An acceptable AP score on an English exam may be used to meet the English Composition requirement but not the Critical Thinking or Oral Communication requirements.
- All classes must be passed with a “C” or higher.
- The majority of units used for IGETC must have been earned at a California Community College.
- UC re-entry students are not eligible to use IGETC.
- Courses on this sheet may be listed in more than one area, but cannot be used to certify more than one area.
- **Students must apply for certification. Forms are available in Evaluations, room A-110.**
- Transfer credit may be limited for certain courses by UC, CSU, or both. See a counselor for additional information.
- Additional certifying courses may be available at Mesa or Miramar Colleges.
