

VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION SHEET

San Diego County
(prepared by SD NAACP)

ELIGIBILITY

You **CAN** register to vote in California if you are:

- A U.S. Citizen
- A California resident
- At least age 18 on or before the next Election Day (17 year-olds may register but will not receive their voter registration card until they turn 18)
- On probation
- Not* in prison for a *felony* (you may vote if you are in county jail for a *misdemeanor*)
- Not* on parole
- Not* found mentally incompetent by a court of law

If you **moved** since the last election, you must **RE-REGISTER**

You can **NOT** register to vote if you are:

- In state prison (or in county jail serving a *state* prison sentence)
- On parole

REGISTRATION FORM



If someone *helps you* OR *mails* your voter registration form, *they* must mail the form **within 3 days** of helping you. (You *both* sign and date the form in the green square.)

Helper: Tear off bottom part of form and give it to person you are helping (the voter).

Write in: Your name, contact number, organization / address (if relevant)



Voter registration must be received or postmarked **15 days** before the election.

ELECTION DAY

If your name is not on the polling list, you may still ask for (vote with) a **Provisional Ballot**.
