



Now Accepting Waiting List Applications!

The Child Development Centers at San Diego City College, San Diego Mesa College and San Diego Miramar College are currently accepting waiting list applications for the fall 2017 semester.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Priority is given to families that meet the California Department of Education guidelines for low income based on family size (proof of income must be verified)
- Preschool children must be 3 or 4 years of age by September 1 of the current year
- A limited amount of space is available for younger children at all three sites. Only City College CDC serves infants
- Priority is given to students enrolled in the San Diego Community College District

SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION:

Bring the following documents to the center you wish your child to attend:

- Proof of Income for all household members
 - TANF/CalWORKs verification (Notice of Action)
 - Payroll check stubs within last 30 days
 - Unemployment and/or Disability
- Immunization records for the child enrolling
- Verification of Family Size
 - List of all family living in household
 - Birth certificate for all children in the home under the age of 18
 - Single Status must be verified through one of the following documents:
 1. Divorce Papers
 2. Custody Agreement
 3. Proof that you filed for child support or executed documents with agency declining to file for child support
 4. Rental agreement or utility bill with current address
