

- 2. Laptops/WiFi hubs distributed to deserving students






# Loving and Supporting Students with Diverse Abilities in Remote Learning

### **State Budget Outlook**

**\$227B** total in the General Fund expenditure budget, which includes:

- \$164.5B in the General Fund
- \$15.6B one-time discretionary surplus
- \$131M COLA (\$2M impact to district)
- \$43M apportionment funding for growth (\$1.2M impact to district)

#### Community College

\$250M: Financial aid grants

\$100M: Basic needs / food / housing

\$30M: Mental health

\$23.1M: Enrollment growth

\$20M: Professional Development

\$15M: Open-sourced textbooks


