Office of Institutional Research Annual Research Agenda 2025/26

The Office of Institutional Research at San Diego City College (SDCC) aims to promote a culture of evidence and inquiry in which accurate data and evidence are generated and developed into useful information for institutional assessment, planning, and improving student learning and institutional effectiveness. Activities directed toward this mission include producing annual reports for academic and student services programs, disseminating information and facilitating discussion, fulfilling reporting requirements, and responding to ongoing campusbased requests for information about student behaviors, outcomes, and experiences.

The 2025/26 SDCC research agenda reflects the core services provided and the projects completed on an annual basis. Additionally, the Office of Institutional Research responds to ad hoc requests throughout the year. Research is prioritized based on the following hierarchy:

- Mandatory reporting and accreditation
- Data to be used in a grant application or to support grant-funded activities
- Scheduled annual reports for evaluating campus programs and student support services
- Research supporting planning or the execution of plans (e.g., strategic plan, integrated plan, Guided Pathways)
- Internal ad hoc requests from the campus community in the order received
- External ad hoc requests that have been approved by the district Institutional Review Board (IRB)

Urgent requests approved at the level of the vice presidents or president may at times take precedence over the order of priority.

The general process for most research requests includes:

- 1. Clarification and finalization of the request
- 2. Research and identification of data sources
- 3. Collection and/or extraction of data, including design of collection instruments
- 4. Analysis of data
- 5. Validation of results and updates to the analysis
- 6. Summary and review of final product(s) or report(s)
- 7. Presentation or discussion of the results with stakeholders

Review of 2024/25 Research Activities

Research Sharing/Transparency. The IREC committee met regularly during the year and reviewed and approved the 2024/25 Research Agenda. The Office of Institutional Research engaged the campus community through service on approximately twenty committees, councils, and workgroups, participation in on-campus retreats and special presentations, and the facilitation of conversations at the program level regarding data and inquiry.

Annual Program Reports. The Office of Institutional Research was able to complete the Title III Annual Performance Report, AANAPISI Grant Annual Performance Report, and AANHPI Annual Student Achievement Report on schedule and engage in robust dialogue and planning towards the next grant cycle. In addition, significant progress has been made toward developing dynamic dashboards to display student and course demographic and outcome data utilizing the district's new supported data software and business intelligence platform Power BI for program review, awards data, as well as various grants and annual reports including the AANHPI Annual Student Achievement Report, Title III/V, Strong Workforce Partnership, and the Student Equity Plan project. Many of these dashboards have been used to provide the data necessary to compete for a number of other grants. The tutoring report and supplemental instruction (SI) report was redesigned into a new Power BI Tutoring Dashboard that will be updated annually. All other annual program reports scheduled in the 2024/25 research agenda have been completed.

Enrollment Management. The enrollment dashboard was updated daily throughout the year. The San Diego Community College District has been utilizing the SDCC Enrollment Management Dashboard districtwide for all campuses to access daily enrollment management data. The Office of Institutional Research at City College continues to support discussion, utilization, and training of all dashboards. The student profile dashboard continues to be maintained and updated annually and was also transitioned over into being a Power BI dashboard.

Program Review. Both instructional and student service program review dashboards were maintained and updated. The formerly separate special populations dashboard was incorporated into the redesigned Power BI program review dashboard and includes populations such as DSPS, EOPS, foster youth students, military/veteran students, single parents, homeless students, City Promise students, City student athletes, and others.

Mandated Reporting. The ACCJC Annual Report and institution-set standards were completed during the spring semester and progress toward the new aspirational goals was reviewed. Ad hoc grant reporting during the year remained significant and there were 34 requests for both mandatory annual reporting in addition to grants. At least 13 different grants required institutional research support. Six requests were for data to pursue new grant proposals and 10 requests were to fulfill reporting requirements and needs for grants already received.

Ad Hoc Requests. In addition to the work detailed above, the Office of Institutional Research fulfilled approximately 32 ad hoc requests from September 2024 through August 2025. Given major staffing constraints and significant increase in grant related needs, this level of performance is considered outstanding by the office.

2025/26 Research Goals and Priorities

In alignment with the goal set through the program review process and in consideration of input provided by the campus community, the following goal will continue to be emphasized over the upcoming year:

Improve access to data and increase efficiency of the Research Office by using tools and processes for consolidating requests, automating data production, and tracking grants across the college.
