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Introduction

Supplemental Instruction is an academic assistance program that provides peer-facilitated weekly group study sessions to improve student retention and success in difficult courses. SI is available for all students in the targeted course who want to improve their understanding of course material and improve their grades. The sessions are facilitated by SI tutors who attend class lectures, take notes, and act as model students. The program strives to positively impact academic achievement and student retention by creating and maintaining dynamic, interactive learning for individuals of all cultures, abilities, backgrounds, and identities.

This report is developed to serve multiple purposes at City College: (1) for accreditation in response to the Library and Learning Resources Support of Accreditation Standard IIB, (2) for the tutorial center administrators to determine best practices and to inform planning, and 3) for City College and the District to decide how services are rendered in the future.

The key questions that this report will address are:

- What is the demographic profile of students who participate in supplemental instruction?
- How well do supplemental instruction students perform in their courses relative to students who do not receive supplemental instruction?
- Are students who participate in supplemental instruction more likely to persist from term to term (fall to spring) compared to students who do not receive supplemental instruction?

Methodology

The report examines student characteristics, enrollment, retention, success, and persistence for students enrolled in courses with SI support who enrolled at City College over the past five years. Students enrolled in SI courses are compared to students enrolled in the same course during the same term that did not have SI support to highlight differences in enrollment characteristics and student outcomes.

Terms and Definitions

SI Student: A student who enrolled in a course section that has an attached supplemental instructor.

Non-SI Student: A student who enrolled in a "comparison" course section without an attached supplemental instructor. For every supplemental instruction course, other sections of the course taught in the same term were included as comparison course sections.

Retention Rates: The percentage of enrollments completed with a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD out of total official census enrollments. Tutoring and cancelled classes are excluded.

Success Rates: The percentage of enrollments completed with a grade of A, B, C, or P out of total official census enrollments. Tutoring, non-credit, and cancelled classes are excluded.

Persistence Rates - Term: The percentage of official census enrolled first-time to college students in a fall term who received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD and who enrolled in at least one course in the subsequent spring term and received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or RD. SDSU and UCSD-only students and sections are excluded. Intersession, tutoring, in-service, and cancelled classes are excluded.

Persistence Rates - Annual: Continuous fall to spring to fall enrollment: The percentage of official census enrolled firsttime to college students in a fall term who received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or RD and who enrolled in at least one course in the subsequent spring and fall terms and received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or RD in each term. SDSU and UCSD-only students and sections are excluded. Intersession, tutoring, in-service, and cancelled classes are excluded.
