2026/27 GOALS

As we enter our second decade, these goals reflect both where we've been and where we're going. Built on ten years of data, relationships, and hard-won progress, our 2026/27 goals are organized into five themes that keep social justice and student success at the center of everything we do and honor our enduring commitment to **HOPE**.

1. A Decade of Transforming Lives: Sustaining the Work

- Full COVID recovery, backed by ten years of data
- Three statewide SEM projects improving scheduling, productivity, and completion
- Rebuilding STEM and establishing Nursing as a standalone school
- Program Review and Block Grant funds sustaining campus efforts
- Hiring across faculty and staff; fundraising to sustain the work
- Creating a safe and caring campus for students, faculty, and staff

2. Belonging & Identity: Supporting Our Affinity Communities

- Block Grant support for AAPI Center, Black Resource Center, and BSI efforts
- Workgroup planning the opening of a Chicanx/Latinx Success Center
- Rebuilding the HUBU learning community
- World Cultures programming funded through Block Grant and GFU/GFR
- 7 employees and 5 students studied abroad in Ghana
- Affinity spaces planned into the A Building Expansion

3. Wraparound Support: Meeting Students Where They Are

- Expanded Mental Health and Counseling support via Block Grant
- FamilyU launched for student parents (\$250,000 IEPI grant submitted)
- Student Mentor Program pilot continues
- Director of Student Housing hired to develop Resident Advisor Program
- Commuter Center opened in the Library
- Basic needs expanded: Food Pantry, Threads & Things, Fresh Cutz Barbershop, Welcome Home City

4. Access to Academic Excellence

- ZTC adopters expanding
- \$1.2 million Cyber Security Lab opened
- Four instructional lab techs added: ceramics, cosmetology, anthropology, Seeds@City
- Tutoring and Transfer Center funded via Block Grant
- Expanded funding for Research Symposium, Open House, and CCAP

5. Building Our Future: Infrastructure That Makes Hope Tangible

- Campus mural projects continue to expand
- Final plans submitted: Saville Theatre, A Building Expansion, Athletics, Library remodel
- Lactation pods added in the Library and AH
- Additional water stations installed campus-wide
- Campus safety updates and SDCCDs safe App
