

At SDCC, we are proud that our campus is a reflection of our rich

diverse urban community. Of the 15,705 students enrolled in fall 2017 at City College, more than 50 percent were Latinx; 10 percent were African American; 36 percent were the first in their families to attend college; and 51 percent were working toward a bachelor's degree. In 2018, the college awarded more than 1,250 degrees and certificates.




Age




