DATA ADVOCACY INSTITUTE SIGN-UP

Curious about how you can shape discussions on student success at our campus? Be part of an “empowering experience” and become a data advocate for City College today!

The Guided Pathways team at City is recruiting participants for our data advocacy institute. Two sessions will be offered: **December 17-19, 2019 and January 27-29, 2020 (9:00am – 3:00pm)**. The institute is a three-day on-campus professional development program designed to build the internal capacity of faculty and others to identify and evaluate relevant data for program improvement and effectiveness.

Last session’s participants came away with:

- Increased awareness about the availability of data on campus
- Stronger interest in institutional research
- Better understanding of how to utilize data to close the equity gap
- Increased data coaching leadership capabilities

“As an adjunct, I felt so grateful for the opportunity to be involved and selected for the institute. I feel more informed on how to use data and to apply it to support programs. The discussions we partook in were very informative and made me critically think about data and how to create a data informed culture at City,” said a past participant.

No previous experience in data/quantitative analysis and/or research methodology is necessary to participate. Per the CBA, **eligible faculty participants will be compensated with one (1) Extended Service Units (ESU) for your three-day participation.**
