ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS 2025-2026

An Associate Degree requires a minimum of 60 degree-applicable semester units, including 12 taken within the San Diego Community College District. Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) and AA-T/AS-T degrees require completion of 60 or more transferable units. All courses required for the major must be completed with a grade of 'C' or better or 'P' (pass) grade; 6 units in the major must be completed at SDCCD. A 2.0 GPA is required in the curriculum upon which the degree is based.

Copies of form DD-214 or DD-295 or Joint Services Transcript (JST) or CCAF Transcript covering all periods of military service must be on file in the Records Office.
