

# SAN DIEGO CITY COLLEGE

## ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS 2022-2023

An Associate Degree requires a minimum of 60 degree-applicable semester units, including 12 taken in residence at the college granting the degree. Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) and AA-T/AS-T degrees require completion of 60 or more transferable units. All courses required for the major must be completed with a grade of 'C' or better or 'P' (pass) grade; 6 units in the major must be completed at SDCCD. A 2.0 GPA is required in the curriculum upon which the degree is based.

**C IP R** **AMERICAN INSTITUTIONS:** Complete **two (2)** courses that cover **US-1, US-2, and US-3.**

**C IP R** **HEALTH EDUCATION:** Complete **Health 101 - 3 units.**

**NOTE:** This requirement is waived for students who earn degrees in Nursing Education, Physical Therapy Assistant, or are graduates of a certified paramedic training program. U.S. Veterans and active-duty U.S. military personnel may be granted two units of college credit to fulfill the Health Education requirement if service has been continuous for at least six months. Copies of form DD-214 or DD-295 or Joint Services Transcript (JST) or CCAF Transcript covering all periods of military service must be on file in the Records Office.

**C IP R** **EXERCISE SCIENCE/DANCE:** Complete **two (2)** activity courses.

**C IP R** Acceptable courses include Exercise Science numbered *below* PHYE 240 or *below* EXSC 229; Dance, except DANC 181, 183, 253; Students with physical conditions which prevent participation in regular exercise science activity classes must file a physician's statement with the College Evaluations Office. Adapted Exercise Science classes are available. A Physician's medical release form is required.

**NOTE:** This requirement is waived for students who possess an accredited Fire Fighter I certification or are graduates of a POST Commission certified regional law enforcement academy. U.S. Veterans and active-duty U.S. military personnel may be granted two units of college credit to fulfill the Exercise Science Activity requirement if service has been continuous for at least six months. Copies of form DD-214 or DD-295 or Joint Services Transcript (JST) or CCAF Transcript covering all periods of military service must be on file in the Records Office.

**C IP R** **MULTICULTURAL STUDIES:** Complete **one** course from 'Area A-D' with a **carat** ^.

**C IP R** **COMPETENCY IN READING AND WRITTEN EXPRESSION:** Complete one course from General Education English Composition **Area 'A1'** with a grade of 'C' or better.

**C IP R** **COMPETENCY IN MATHEMATICS:** Complete **one** course with a grade of 'C' or better.
